PECOS P2P and related applications and services are delivered to end users as web-based applications. This document provides details of the browsers and associated technologies that Elcom certifies as being supported as of PECOS version 18.0.

Applications work with the vast majority of current browsers, and several are tested and certified at the time of the release of each product version. Elcom's policy is to support the most current version as well as the previous version of those internet browsers. The most current versions that have been certified are as below.

2 Web Browsers

PECOS v18.0 is designed to work with the latest versions of all the major internet browsers. They have been tested and are certified for the following versions.

Elcom will provide support for operating systems and browsers under support. Elcom will review issues on a best efforts basis with operating systems and browsers which are no longer supported but may not be able to recreate issues or provide fixes.

SSL/TLS: All web browsers must support https://.

Cookies: It is recommended that session cookies be enabled in users' browsers when accessing PunchOut sites.

Adobe: Some objects in the system are rendered as Adobe Acrobat PDF files and the latest version of Adobe Acrobat Reader is recommended. A minimum of version 6.0 to view Purchase Orders and exported reports is required. The current version of Adobe Reader is available to download free from: www.adobe.com.

3 Mobile Devices

PECOS v18.0 can be used on most tablet computers but at the present time, none are certified.

PECOS is an information-rich application and many of its screens are complex: display on Smartphone browsers may not, therefore, be suitable.

PECOS-Mobile is a new set of web pages developed for use specifically on major Smartphone web browsers. The following major operating systems have been tested for use:

- iOS: 15.6.1
- Android: 12.0

4 Hardware

It is expected that the latest hardware platform that is recommended for the chosen browser should be used. A display resolution of 720p (aspect ratio of 16.9) minimum is required for optimal resolution to accommodate the updated user interface.
